

Weston Infant and Junior Academies Behaviour Policy Covid 19 Update

To help prevent the spread of infection

- The start of the school day will be staggered to limit the number of pupils on the yard.
- The end of the school day will also be staggered to limit the number of pupils on the yard at any one time.
- Parents will not be allowed on to the school grounds (both Academies) or to park on the car park at Weston Junior Academy and all parents will be expected to adhere to rules around social distancing (2m apart).
- Pupils will wash their hands on arrival in school and at least hourly thereafter, they will wash their hands before they leave the school premises to go home.
- Pupils will be kept in small social 'bubbles' within each year group with allocated members of staff.
- These social bubbles will be allocated an area in school and there will be no mixing between the groups.
- Key Worker pupils will be kept within a separate social bubble.
- Lunch and break times will be staggered.
- Lunch will be served in the allocated areas.

Expectations for the behaviour of pupils.

- When moving around the school use the arrows on the floor to ensure you are 2 metres apart.
- Pupils will be expected to socially distance in the corridors.
- If pupils cough or sneeze use a tissue – catch it, bin it, kill it – then wash your hands carefully.
- Try not to touch your mouth, nose, eyes with your hands.
- If you feel unwell – tell an adult immediately.
- Only use your equipment – do not share your pencils etc as this may spread germs (equipment will be provided for each pupil where possible).
- Make sure you drink from your water bottle and no-one else's, ask a teacher if you are not sure it is your bottle.
- Ask an adult if you want to go to the toilet – make sure you flush it and wash your hands afterwards.
- At playtime make sure that you remain 2 metres from your friends. Adults will do their best to make sure you do this.
- Do not cough or spit at anyone – this will spread germs and will result in you being sent home and not being allowed to return.
- If you are not in school (N, Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5) you must continue with your home learning.
