What are we learning?

At Weston Infant Academy...

Nursery are:

- Learning rhythm and rhyme through 'U Hoo's' drumming
- Playing animal sounds guessing with Green Froggy as he visits the farm
- Ordering the story scene for 'Jack and the Beanstalk'
- Practising writing our names on leaves
- · Ordering numbers as they go up the beanstalk
- Making shape drawings
- · Sorting Jack and the Giant's clothes looking at size
- · Beanstalk crafts
- Constructing in the clouds shapes in shaving foam
- Threading beanstalks

Reception are:

- In phonics Group 1 will be focusing on CVCC words
- Group 2 will be learning the Tricky Witch 'er'
- Writing part of the story of 'The Enormous Turnip'
- Looking at 'How many now?' in Maths e.g. First I have 5 and 1 goes now I have 4
- Learning about pushes and pulls as forces
- Creating vegetable art
- Building an obstacle course for the cat

Year 1 are:

- . Group 1 are revising the phonemes 'ee', 'ea' (Green Froggy), 'ea' (Ghosts) and 'er'
- Group 2 are revising the phonemes 'air, ear, are' Tricky Witch 'air'
- Looking at the life-cycle of a hen and writing labels, time connectives
- Writing labels for parts of a crocodile using expanded noun phrases
- Learning about fractions by looking at half of an object or shape
- Recognising and finding half of a quantity
- Sharing equal groups of 2, 5, 10
- Looking at life-cycles in Science
- Learning about Aboriginal tribes and where they live
- Making message sticks of Aboriginal tubes

Year 2 are:

- Revision of 'ev'
- Reading and writing explanations including the life-cycle of animals using technical vocabulary, sub-headings, conjunctions and sentence openers

What are we learning?

Year 2 continued:

- Using conjunctions to explain uses of body parts
- Looking at quarters and thirds of amounts
- Looking at life-cycles in Science
- Learning about Aboriginal tribes and where they live
- Making message sticks of Aboriginal tubes

At Weston Junior Academy...

J1 are:

- Learning prepositions of time and creating prepositional phrases using these
- Looking at subtraction using fractions with the same denominator
- Thinking about how we can make Britain 'hedgehog friendly' in Science and PSHE
- Creating a Roman mosaic in Art
- Continuing to learn how to use Spanish to order an ice cream (cone or tub)

J2 and J3 are:

- Using show not tell in English
- Using punctuation to demarcate speech
- Converting money between pounds and pence
- Adding money
- Considering how the Holy Spirit is part of the Christian story of Pentecost

What are we learning?

Year 5 are:

- Drafting and editing 'The Oracle' focusing on suspense and atmosphere
- Carrying out short multiplication
- Looking at the conversion of measures
- Playing kwik cricket in P.E.
- Creating formulas using numbers in Computing
- Reading 'The Good Samaritan' in R.E.
- Thinking about how we can control anger and what causes people to be angry in PSHE

Year 6 are:

- Focusing on comprehension when reading chapter 11 of 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone'
- Revising noun phrases, sentence functions (statement, command, question, exclamation), formality, perfect/progressive tense, homophones, pronouns, all punctuation
- Looking at how to find the area/perimeter of compound shapes and triangles
- Using the inverse
- Sorting diagrams
- Learning about the English Civil War
- Considering what Jesus' sacrifice means to Christians
